Connections, a program of the Child and Family Resource Council, is a program that informs parents on the appropriate development of their children ages 0-5, through age specific developmental questionnaires and by connecting parents to community resources. The questionnaires utilize playtime to help parents and caregivers both encourage healthy development of children as well as identify any potential developmental delays.

Become part of a team that can positively impact many families in your community. You can help support Connections families by scoring children's Ages and Stages Questionnaires (ASQ), putting mailings together, making copies, filing, and entering child/family information electronically. Comprehensive training will be provided. We ask that an approximate 2-hour per week, yearlong commitment be given. We are flexible with all scheduling and offer both day and evening hours. We also understand the need for time off/vacation. Parking is free, mileage can be tax deductible, and the work environment is friendly – we'd love to have you join our team!
